**INFORMATION CLAUSE REGARDING PERSONAL DATA PROCESSING**  
**FOR PARTICIPANTS OF THE PHOTO COMPETITION**  
**FUJIFILM MOMENT STREET PHOTO AWARDS 2023**

In order to perform the obligation specified in art. 13 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation - Journal of Laws UE.L of 2016, No. 119), "GDPR", we inform that:

- The administrator of personal data obtained from participants is the Częstochowa Museum, with its registered office at Al. NMP 47, 42-217 Częstochowa, phone no. 34 360 56 31, e-mail: [museum@muzeumczestochowa.pl](mailto:museum@muzeumczestochowa.pl).
- In all matters regarding the protection of personal data, you can contact the Inspector of Personal Data Protection appointed at the Museum by e-mail [iodo@muzeumczestochowa.pl](mailto:iodo@muzeumczestochowa.pl) or by phone 34 360 56 31.
- The administrator will process the personal data of participants in order to organize and conduct the competition on the terms set out in the Regulations of the FUJIFILM MOMENT STREET PHOTO AWARDS 2023 Competition and the organization of the post-competition exhibition based on consent to the processing of personal data - art. 6 sec. 1 lit. and the GDPR. Participants have the right to withdraw this consent at any time before the conclusion of the Competition by sending relevant information to the e-mail address [iodo@muzeumczestochowa.pl](mailto:iodo@muzeumczestochowa.pl). Withdrawal of consent does not affect the lawfulness of the processing that was made on the basis of consent before its withdrawal. Withdrawal of consent to the processing of personal data by the Participant is equivalent to resignation from participation in the Competition. Personal data will also be processed for the purposes of: fulfilling the legal obligations incumbent on the Administrator, e.g. issuing, storing accounting documents - art. 6 sec. 1 point c of the GDPR, conducting and supporting artistic and cultural activities, as part of the Administrator's statutory activities, as tasks carried out in the public interest - art. 6 section 1 lit. e GDPR, determination, protection and pursuit of claims related to the Competition - art. 6 sec. 1 lit. f GDPR.
- Providing the participant's personal data is voluntary, but necessary to participate in the competition.
- The recipients of the personal data of the participants will be the Co-organizers of the competition, the jury of the competition, the recipients may also be entities providing legal and IT services to the Administrator and Co-organizers, bodies authorized to receive your personal data on the basis of legal provisions. Recipients can also be people with access to promotional materials and competition publications, people following publications in the media.
- Personal data of participants will be processed during the implementation of activities related to the organization of the competition, and then for archival purposes in accordance with the office and archive standards of the Częstochowa Museum.
- Competition participants have the right to: access their personal data (in accordance with Article 15 of the GDPR), request their rectification (in accordance with Article 16 of the GDPR), request removal of personal data (in accordance with Article 17 of the GDPR) - if:

personal data are no longer necessary for the purposes for which they were collected or for which they were processed, and in the event that personal data are processed unlawfully, to object to the processing of personal data (in accordance with Article 21 of the GDPR), to request restriction of processing (in accordance with from Article 18 of the GDPR),

- Competition participants have the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory body - the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection if they consider that the processing of their personal data violates the provisions of the GDPR.

- Personal data of competition participants will not be used for automated decision making, including profiling.

- We do not transfer your data outside the European Economic Area, subject to the transnational nature of data flow within Facebook and Instagram. Facebook and Instagram may transfer your data outside the European Economic Area. At the same time, we point out that Facebook and Instagram declare the use of typical contractual clauses approved by the European Commission and relying on the decisions of the European Commission stating the appropriate level of data protection in relation to specific countries to which data may be transferred.
